

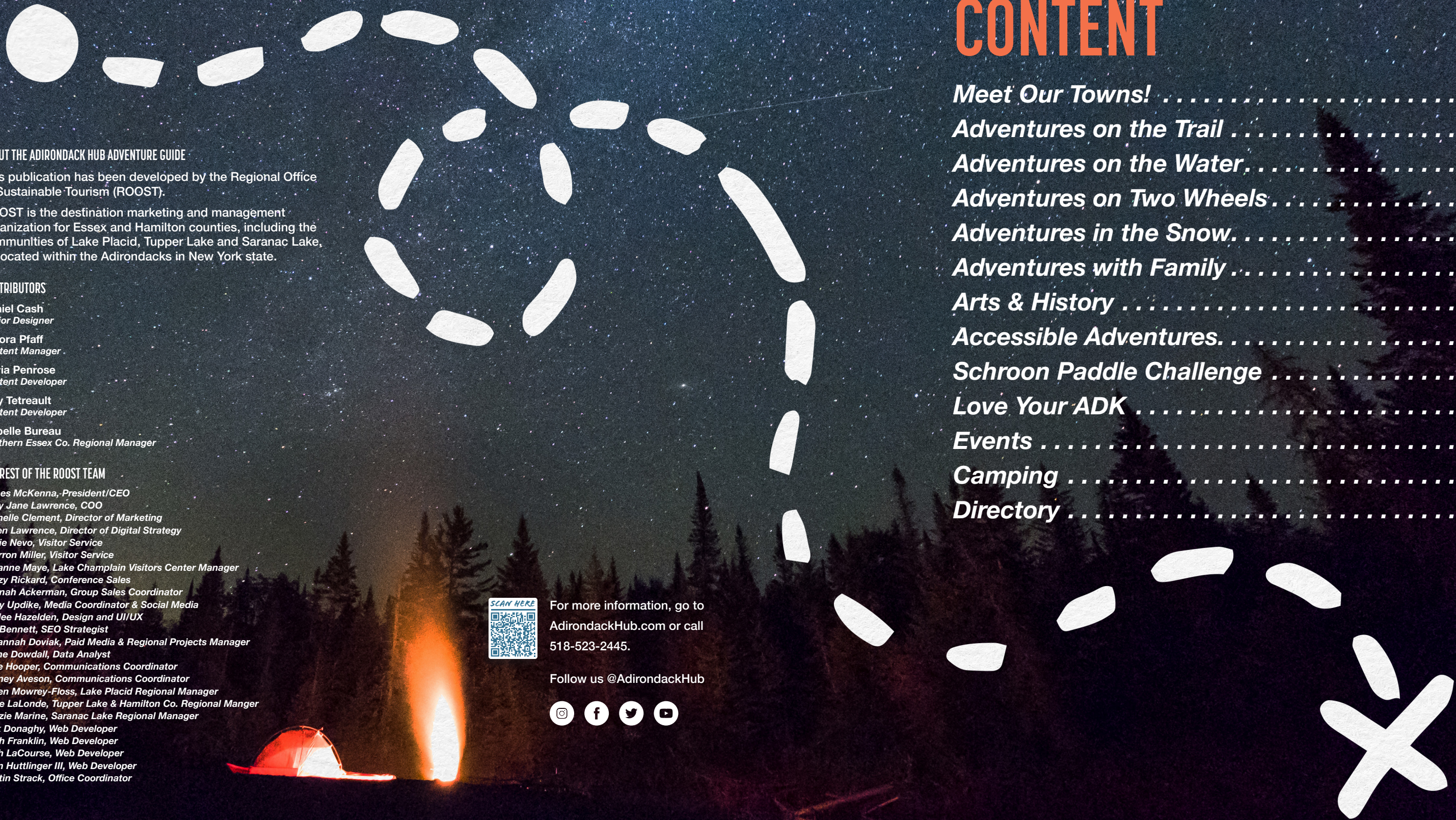

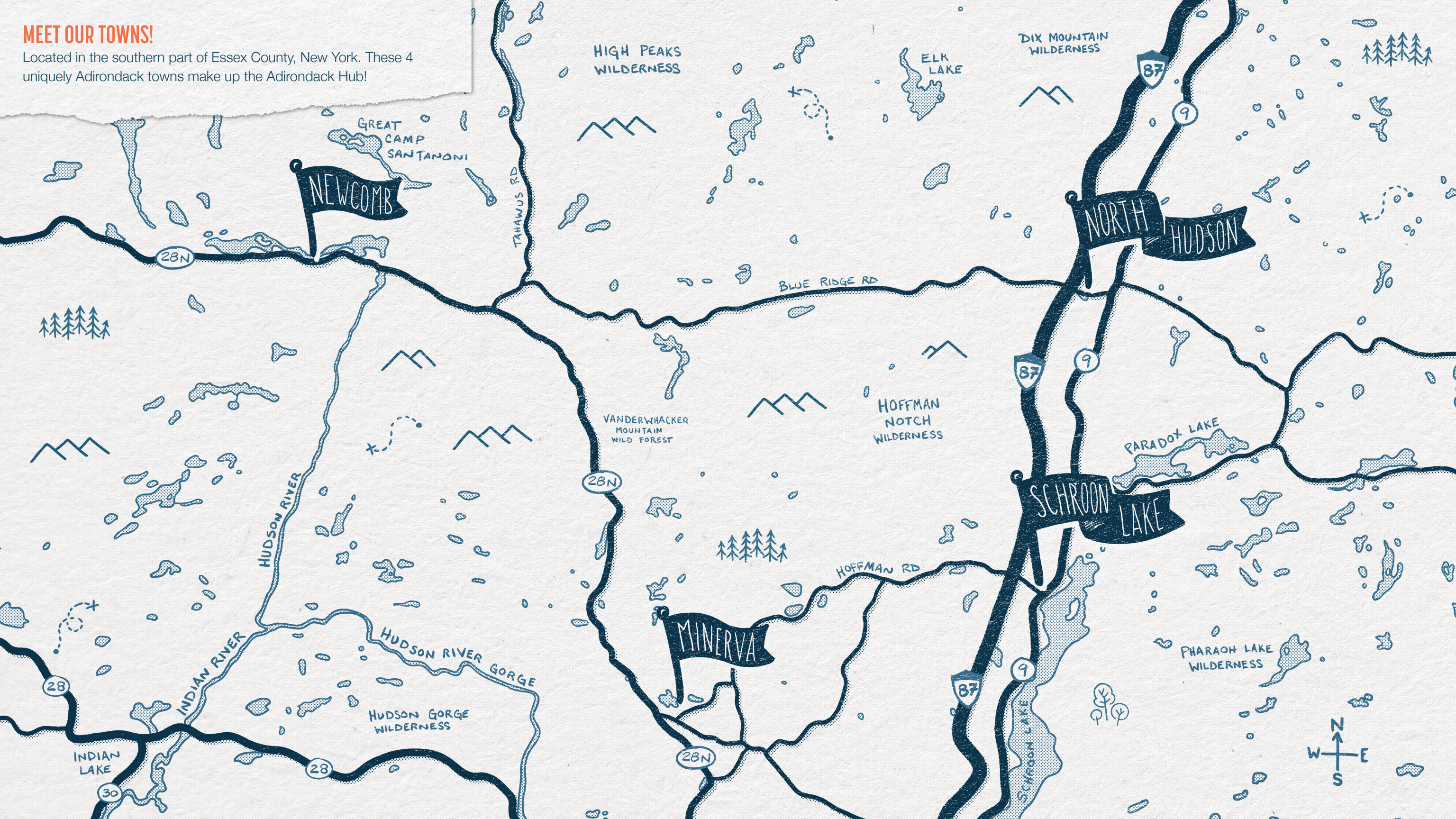

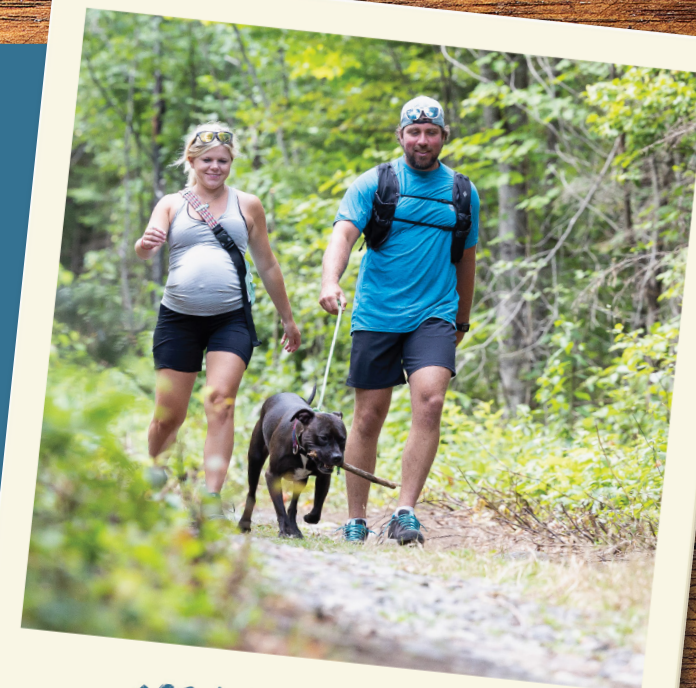

## HIT THE TRAIL WITH SOME OF OUR FAVORITE HIKES!

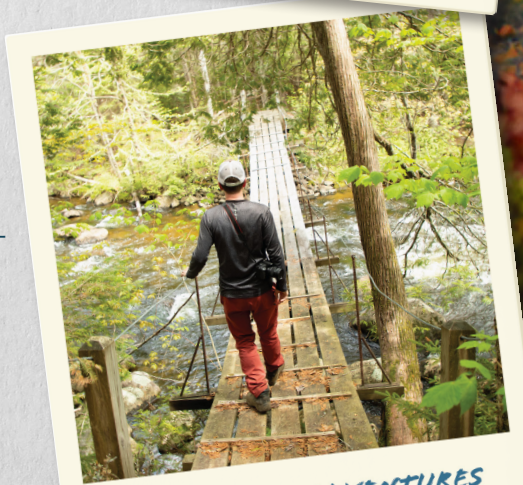
- Cheney Pond in Newcomb — 1 mile R/T, 160' elevation gain, secluded scenery awaits at the end of the short walk down to the pond.
- Blue Ledges in Minerva — 5 miles R/T, 600' elevation gain, offers fresh air and unique views of the Hudson River Gorge.
- Goodnow Mountain in Newcomb — Summit 2,664', 3.8 miles R/T, 1,075' elevation gain, with a historic fire tower.
- Moxham Mountain in Minerva — Summit 2,360', 5 miles R/T, 1360' elevation gain, steady moderate climb with frequent viewpoints.
- Mt. Severance in Schroon Lake — Summit 1,693', 2.4 miles R/T, 725' elevation gain, great views of Schroon Lake.
- Dix Range in North Hudson — Highest summit 4,840', 15 miles R/T, 5,300' elevation gain, a challenging loop of 5 of the 46 High Peaks.
- Upper Works Trailhead in Newcomb — Gateway into the Southern High Peaks.
- Adirondack Interpretive Center (AIC) in Newcomb — Explore miles of gentle trails.
- Pharaoh Lake Wilderness Area in Schroon Lake — Home to more than 70 miles of trails.
- Hoffman Notch Wilderness Area in Minerva, North Hudson, and Schroon Lake — More than 38,000 secluded acres tucked between two mountain ranges.

# ADVENTURES ON THE WATER

The Adirondack Hub is a nature lover's paradise, and there is no shortage of fun activities to be had on the water. From pristine lakes and meandering rivers to rushing waterfalls and tranquil streams, explore all the ways to have splashing fun!



## OUR BEST PADDLES

### Canoeing and Kayaking

- Boreas Ponds Tract boasts views of the High Peaks that dominate the scene of this 320-acre waterbody. Several rivers and brooks also connect on this tract.
- Lower Schroon River descends from Schroon Lake to the Hudson (27 miles) and is a mixture of long flatwater stretches punctuated by whitewater. Find easy access at points along the way, but go unnoticed while on the tree-lined, secluded river.
- The Opalescent River empties into the iconic Hudson River, just south of Tahawus. It is designated a Wild River for 11 miles from Flowed Lands to its confluence with the Hudson. This makes it a truly wild paddling experience!
- The region is home to the eight lakes of the Essex Chain Lakes, plus 10 other paddle-able waterbodies.

### Fishing

- As one of the largest lakes in the Adirondack Hub, Schroon Lake has plenty of space for folks to fish from the shore, from their kayaks or canoes, and motorboats. Find yourself setting the hook on species like largemouth bass or lake trout!
- The 45-acre Minerva Lake contains largemouth bass and perch. The lake has always had a good reputation for fishing.
- Another great lake in the Town of Newcomb, Lake Harris is fantastic for snagging the perfect fish, either from the shore or watercraft.
- A calmer spot, Balfour Lake is located between Minerva and Newcomb, and is ideal for canoe or kayak fishing.

# ADVENTURES ON TWO WHEELS

Let the good times roll as you explore the expanse of the Adirondack Hub along a route that's perfect for you.

## DIVERSE TERRAIN

Adirondack Hub gravel biking paves the way to un-paved adventures big and small!

- Explore historic Great Camp Santanoni via the 5-mile gravel former carriage road.
- Essex Chain Lakes offers a variety of terrain through a 23-mile loop.
- Spectacular High Peaks views await along the multi-use road at Boreas Pond Tract.

## AMP UP YOUR SPEED

Explore quiet roads, grand views, and classic Adirondack small town hospitality.

- Breathe easy on a pleasant loop through the charming small towns of Schroon Lake, Minerva, Newcomb, and North Hudson.
- Take in the scenery of Blue Ridge Falls from a quiet pull-off above the river, or stretch your legs on a short hike to the water's edge.
- Stop to enjoy a leisurely rest, complete with picnic facilities and big Adirondack views, at Newcomb Overlook.



# ADVENTURES IN THE SNOW

Winter brings about unique recreation opportunities in the Hub. Gliding across the snow on a pair of cross-country skis can be exhilarating, while lounging on a lake waiting for the flag on your tip-up to rise can be a relaxing day outdoors.



## SNOWSHOEING & CROSS-COUNTRY SKIING

- Easy - Crane Pond, 4 miles R/T, 350 feet of elevation gain, leads to a scenic little pond.
- Moderate - Camp Santanoni, 10 miles R/T, 950 feet of elevation gain, with a taste of Adirondack history.
- Difficult - Pharaoh Lake from the south, 9 miles R/T, 600 feet of elevation gain, all in the backcountry.
- Alpine Ski/Snowboard - For more adventure, head over to Gore Mountain for world-class downhill skiing and snowboarding.

## ICE FISHING

- Schroon Lake - 4,107 surface acres of ice, and a popular annual ice fishing derby.
- Eagle Lake - Average depth of 19 feet, known for brown trout.
- Lake Harris - 40 feet at maximum depth, and the northern pike are numerous.
- Paradox Lake - 896 surface acres, great chances for large lake trout.

## SNOWMOBILING

Ride through snowy forests and over frozen lakes with a classic snowmobile trip! A mix of groomed and un-groomed trails await.

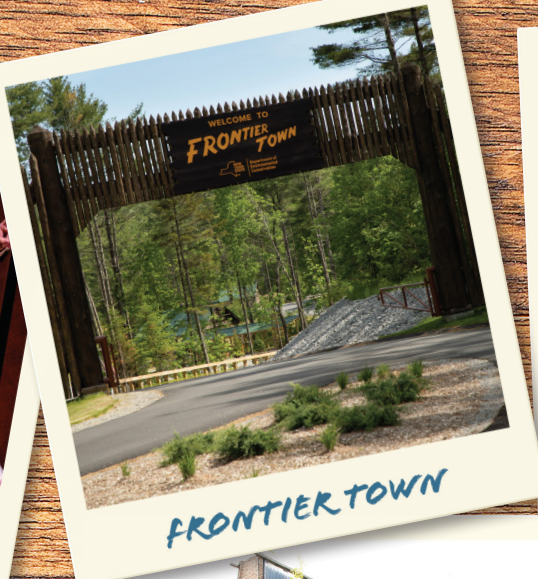
# ART, CULTURE, AND HISTORICAL ADVENTURES

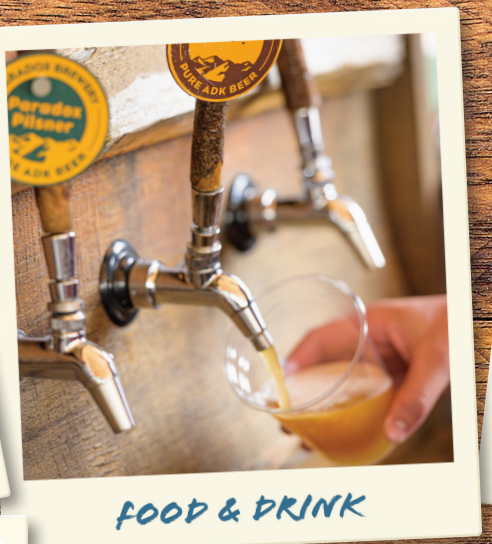
- Seagle Festival for outstanding opera and musical productions in the Hub.
- Adirondack Shakespeare Company for professional Shakespeare in Schroon Lake.
- Schroon Lake Summer Square Dancing is a summer tradition! Get your do-si-do on with the locals at a lakeside park.
- Great Camp Santanoni and Preserve, a historic landmark of one of the earliest examples of the Adirondack Great Camps.
- Once known as Tahawus, an iron ore mining village, the Upper Works is now generally considered a ghost town. A new promenade with historical interpretation has recently been added.
- Connect with the Minerva Historical Society and celebrate Winslow Homer, who, as a summer visitor, painted most of his famous Adirondack works in this area.
- Local arts and crafts, sold in shops throughout the Hub, and at craft fairs throughout the year.

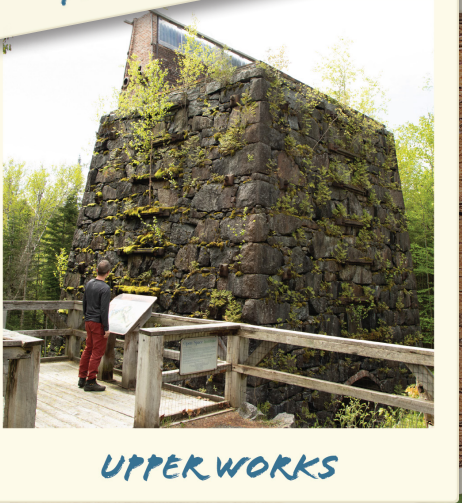

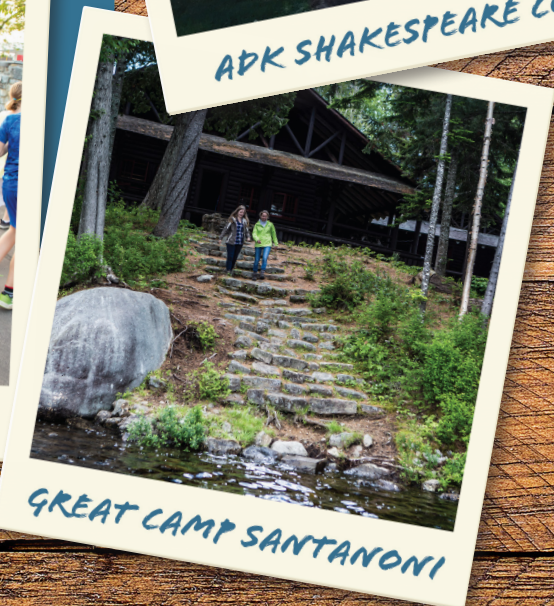
